Visitors are asked to respect property, plants and animals at each site. Bring your camera, sun screen and a cooler to chill any products purchased.

Bees and other flying insects are important to nature's cycle. Many of the farm sites intentionally feature plants that encourage pollination. If you have allergies, please be prepared!

All parking should be off the road and on the farm's property with potentially uneven terrain. Weather may cause some animals to take shelter from the elements and cause some areas to be muddy.

Door prize registration is available at each stop. All sites feature a picnic area for visitors. In addition, all sites accept payments in cash, credit or debit cards.

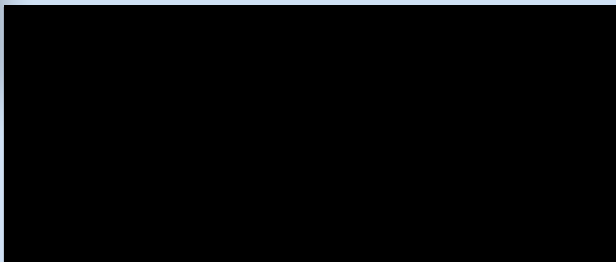
